Challenge

- > Overselling during product launches due to delays in system integrations between their website and third-party logistics providers.
- > Lack of real-time synchronization across platforms, leading to inventory inaccuracies.
- > Operational inefficiencies impacting customer satisfaction during high-demand periods.

- 1** Developed custom API endpoints (RESTlets) within NetSuite to handle tens of thousands of transactions per batch.
- 2** Improved integration between the website and 3PL systems to ensure real-time data synchronization.
- 3** Established NetSuite as the central system of record for inventory and accounting.
